

**PROCEDURES FOR REVOCATION/MOTION TO ADJUDICATE
HEARINGS IN THE 7TH DISTRICT COURT**

FORMS REQUIRED:

1. Written Plea Admonishments and Stipulation of Evidence
2. Trial Court's Certification of Defendant's Right of Appeal
3. 39.14 Discovery Compliance Form
4. Written Admonition on Ineligibility to Possess Firearm or Ammunition

All forms must be completed by all parties (Attorney, Defendant and State) and provided to the Court *at least 3 (three) business days* prior to the hearing.

Any exhibits must be presented to opposing counsel and provided to the Court clearly labeled *no later than 3:00 p.m. on the business day prior to the hearing*.

If the Defendant is on bond, they must appear in person in the 7th District Courtroom for the hearing.

You must advise the Court if you anticipate calling witnesses. Hearings are set in 45-minute slots and if more time will be required, you must notify the Court as soon as possible or it may become necessary to reschedule if time is not available on the date given.
