



Smith County Opioid Settlement Reimbursement Grant Application

Smith County joined many states and other local political subdivisions to bring litigation against large pharmaceutical distributors, manufacturers and pharmacy chains. Several settlements were reached with Smith County, and we have formulated a plan to disperse some of these funds. There are multiple ways in which Smith County may use the funds, but consensus of the Commissioners Court is to focus on providing treatment and recovery support services, such as residential and inpatient treatment, intensive outpatient treatment, outpatient therapy or counseling, and recovery housing.

The grant reimbursement program will ensure all expenditures fit the opioid settlement requirements. We are asking organizations in Smith County that directly participate in the treatment and recovery services listed above to make an application for this grant funding by emailing Casey Murphy at Cmurphy@smith-county.com with the following information:

1. What services do you directly provide for patients affected by opioids?

2. Have you received any Opioid Settlement Funds already? If so, how much?

3. How will you utilize the grant funding if awarded?

All qualified applicants will be scheduled to come to a Commissioners Court meeting to present your needs regarding the grant reimbursement funds. The Commissioners Court will consider all the information and make the decision as to how the funding shall be dispersed.
